Welcome to the Sailing Season of 2010/11

This year we have a jam packed program and there is the possibility of more to come. Watch for further information.

Attached are the new Seasons information sheet, enrolment form, and the program as it stands at the moment.

The club house main hall has been temporarily fixed but it is expected that later in the year the roof will be totally replaced and the tower rebuilt. Until then we will have to make do with a temporary set up.

This year the Training Committee and General Committee have decided to reintroduce:

1. a training fee (which is \$85 per course) and
2. a fee for use of the pacers in the afternoon (\$10 per person).

While Sat 16/10/10 is noted as a registration time, it is expected that the courses maybe full by that time as registrations are being taken now. The courses starting on that date mean that you should come prepared to go sailing.

Places are limited on each of the program courses and I encourage you to book early or you may miss out.

BOOKINGS for these courses are essential! (Do not assume you are booked onto any course unless you have given your forms to me (James Robinson) and you have received confirmation of your place.

Level 1 -2 Courses.

Racing program

Those wanting to move to the race training program need to see Paul Cappy and while Paul will be happy to see you, he will be happier to see you AND you log book. If you are having problems in completing your log, don't worry; just talk it over with Paul.

Level 3 Courses

We have not included a level 3 into the program at this stage but we may be able to. Again as with the racing program see myself or Paul Cappy to discuss your interest in the level 3.

Cadets program

Bookings are being taken now.

NB: those wanting to use the club Pacers for racing **MUST book and register by 12:30pm** with the **Race Coordinating Instructor** who will be waiting by the blackboard in the boat shed. The Race coordinating Instructor will decide allocations to boats at that time. The **Race coordinating Instructor's** decision is final in **ALL** matters relating to boat allocations/safety etc. (remember that a \$10 fee per person applies for the use of a club pacer).

- ◆ You are reminded about the sign in/off procedure
- ◆ Parents / guardians are expected to be involved in the program.
E.g. helping the children get the boats out of the boat shed, rigged and also at the end of the sessions helping put away boats.
